About half the households in the Warnervale district have already completed the long version of the Connecting the Community survey. The survey was mailed to all households in July and is part of a project to help build the local community.

The survey asks questions about the many things we need to understand to build a community. Some of the questions are personal, eg. questions about your views and how you experience the local community.

The survey is **anonymous**. You do not need to put your name on it.

The findings from the survey will be used:

- to identify priorities for community development,
- as **a baseline to monitor changes** taking place in the local community over the next few years, **and**
- to increase our knowledge of the way communities work so we can build better communities.
