We need a picture of the whole community

Dear Resident

This is the **short version** of the Connecting the Community survey. The survey is part of a project to help understand and build the local community.

The survey is being given to one person in each household in the Warnervale district which has **not** already returned a completed long version of the survey. Where there is more than one person living in a household we are asking for the person, aged 18 years or over, with the first birthday after January 1^{st,} to complete the survey. This will ensure we have a random sample.

This is a **joint project** of Wyong Shire Council and UnitingCare Burnside. If you would like any further information, please contact Sandra Heitmanek at Council on ph: 4350 5171.

All the information you pass onto us in the survey is **anonymous** (do not put your name on the questionnaire). It will also remain confidential (individual questionnaires will not be released).

The **report** of the findings from the survey will be made available to the community. It will describe the community as a whole. A summary will be provided to each household along with information about how to get a copy of the full report.

We wish to be able to send reminders to follow up late survey returns because it is important we hear from every household. To maintain anonymity and allow us to follow up late returns could you:

- Complete the survey and put it in the mail by Friday 31st August in the reply paid envelope provided. Mail it to Wyong Council, Reply Paid 20, Wyong, NSW 2259
- Mail the enclosed postcard (which says you have put your completed questionnaire in the mail) to Reply Paid 72863 Warnervale NSW 2259 so we know who has returned the questionnaire - but we will not know which questionnaire is yours.

Are you the right person to fill out the questionnaire?

Are you the person in the household, aged 18 years or over, who has the first birthday after January 1st this year?

- YES please continue and complete the survey
- NO please ask that person to complete the survey

For example, if there are two adults in the household, and one has his/her birthday in March and the other adult has his/her birthday in August then the adult with the birthday in March should complete the questionnaire.

It is very important that this person completes the survey. It is our way of ensuring that we have a random sample of residents. This is essential for the success of the survey.
